Subject: Level 2 Certificate in Further Mathematics (KS4)

Curriculum Intent:

With its requirement for students to face the unexpected and to apply their knowledge to unfamiliar contexts, throughout their Maths education at The Hazeley Academy, students are taught the building blocks they need to be successful. The focus evolves from knowing the facts, to knowing how to apply the concepts to solve problems, and evaluating the appropriateness and limitations of different strategies in diverse contexts.

Within the curriculum, retrieval is used to draw on links with new and known content. Time is given over to those students who need more time to form their building blocks, developing their confidence, and making their own links between the concepts before they are ready to progress.

We use the White Rose Education Maths framework as a basis for our Scheme of Learning
